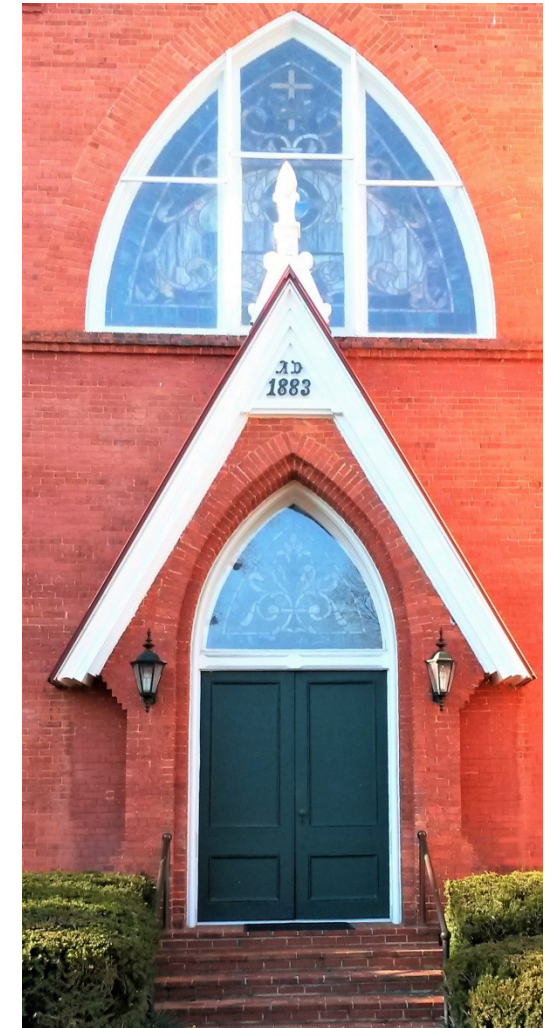

BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLIES

We are again collecting school supplies for needy children in Washington County through Faith in Action. There is a basket located outside of the office for the collection of donations. The bags should be marked COMPLETED when placed in the basket. Monetary donations are accepted if you wish for someone to purchase the supplies for you (\$10 suggested donation.) the following is a list of the items needed per bag:

- 2 packs of 70 of wide ruled paper (or equivalent)
- 2 packs spiral bound notebook paper
- 1 composition book
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 2 erasers
- 1 pencil box
- 2 packs of 10 - #2 pencils (or equivalent)
- 1 pack of 10 pens (either black or blue ink)
- 1 pack colored pencils (usually come in packs of 10 or 12)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors
