lotion (11 oz. or less), 1 bottle roll-on/spray deodorant (4 oz.

or less), 1 small spray perfume/cologne/body mist (4 oz. or

less). Pack these separately in sandwich-size Zip-Loc bag: 1

tube antibiotic ointment (1 oz.), 1 bottle
