BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLIES

We are again collecting school supplies for needy children in Washington County through Faith in Action. There is a box outside of the church office for the collection of the donations. The bags should be marked COMPLETED when placed in the box. Monetary donations are accepted if you wish for someone to purchase the supplies them. A suggested donation is \$15 per bag. Money should be turned in no later than July 1.

The following is a list of the items needed per bag:

- 2 packs of 70 of wide ruled paper (or equivalent)
- 2 packs spiral bound notebook paper
- 1 composition book
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 2 erasers
- 1 pencil box
- 2 packs of 10 - #2 pencils (or equivalent)
- 1 pack of 10 pens (either black or blue ink)
- 1 pack colored pencils (usually come n packs of 10 or 12)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair Fiskar scissors
